**Quilt Tying:** Ann Guse reported that the 2<sup>nd</sup> quilt tying session took place today and they could have used more help. Quilt tying takes place every Tuesday at the DelPonte home (793 Donald St.). All hands are welcome.

**Sock, Mitten, Hat Collection:** Our February collection for the needy seems to be going well. No one present at our meeting has been to St. Andrew's recently to see how the collection is going there. (**Update:** via email, Cathy indicated a couple bags of items have been donated at St. Andrew's so far.) Phyllis will take down the St. Mary's display and Cathy will take down the St. Andrew's display at the end of February.

**Church Health Services:** Marge Brandel reported that this service will not be starting in March as previously hoped and discussed at our last meeting, however, she was not sure why. We will discuss again as further developments occur.
